## School Annual Education Report (AER) Cover Letter

Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER), which provides key information on the 2022-23 educational progress for the Grant Township School. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. For the 2023-24 school year, schools were identified based on previous years' performance using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that had at least one underperforming student subgroup in 2022-23. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that had a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state in 2021-22. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance was in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or had a graduation rate at or below 67% in 2021-22. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given. The Grant Township School has not received any of these labels.

The M-STEP is administered each year at the Copper Harbor School. However, because of our small population of students, it would be unethical to display the results publically. Rest assured, the students at the Copper Harbor School perform well on these state assessments.

State law requires that we also report additional information:

### 1. PROCESS FOR ASSIGNING PUPILS TO THE SCHOOL

The Grant Township School participates in Schools of Choice serving students in kindergarten through eighth grades. Ninth through twelfth grade students have the option of attending the Public Schools of Calumet, Laurium, and Keweenaw.

## 2. THE STATUS OF THE 3-5 YEAR SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN

The Grant Township School collaborates with the Copper Country ISD's continuous improvement series using MiCIP. The current goal of the Grant Township School's improvement plan is to meet the technological learning needs of each individual student. Each student's needs dictate the implementation of the curriculum. Core curriculum materials may be viewed at the school by appointment.


